By signing up to an annual CIBBS programme schools will be able to meet the Gatsby benchmarks and Baker Clause.

Schools can link their Curriculum to their Careers plan and engage more closely with their local business community, creating meaningful employment opportunities for their students.

How does CIBBS work?

Each term, Careers Ideas organise an industry employer to come into school to deliver a Career talk about their industry and highlight the employment opportunities for students.

Following the Business Bites session schools will have the option to book two Career planning workshops. These can be delivered in small groups or on a 1:1 basis to enable all students to be 'work ready' including those with EHCP plans.
